Christoph Lampert – Short Bio

Christoph Lampert is a professor at the Institute of Science and Technology Austria (ISTA), where he heads the research group for Machine Learning and Computer Vision since 2010. He also serves as director for the local ELLIS Unit and as ISTA's representative on the board of directors for the FWF Cluster of Excellence *Bilateral Artificial Intelligence*. Before joining ISTA he received a PhD in mathematics from the University of Bonn and held postdoctoral positions at the German Research Center for Artificial Intelligence (DFKI) in Kaiserslautern and at the Max Planck Institute for Biological Cybernetics at Tübingen.

His research on computer vision and machine learning has won several awards, in particular best paper prizes at the CVPR and ECCV conferences. In 2012 he was awarded an ERC Starting Grant (Consolidator Phase) by the European Research Council. He is an action editor for the Journal of Machine Learning Research (JMLR) and served previously as editor for the International Journal of Computer Vision (IJCV) and as associate editor-in-chief of the IEEE Transactions on Pattern Analysis and Machine Intelligence (TPAMI). Since 2019 he has been invited three times into the ERC Starting Grant evaluation panel (PE6, computer science).
